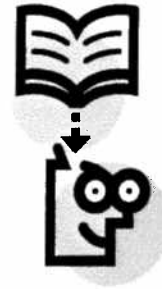
Arizona PTA Scholarship

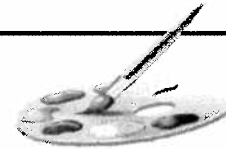
MARCH 2010 PTSA READING PROGRAMS
