To promote the health, safety, and welfare of children.

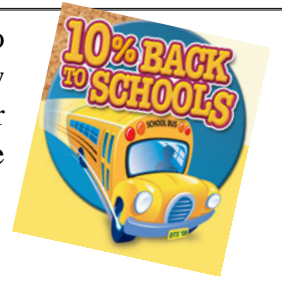
